2019 United States Studies Centre - University of Sydney - Student Behaviour Contract

I would like to congratulate you on your successful application to participate in the 2019 UCLA Study Abroad Program. The objectives of the program are to experience living and studying in the US through a 6-week study program at the University of California, Los Angeles.

Student Responsibility

You will also be aware that as part of your participation in the program you must:

- 1. read and sign the Student Behaviour Contract (as amended from time to time at the University of Sydney and United States Studies Centre's sole discretion);
- 2. provide the required supplementary admission documentation;
- 3. obtain the necessary visa and associated travel documentation following receipt of acceptance onto the program. The University of Sydney and United States Studies Centre does not take any responsibility for you not being able to meet the requirements of your student visa applications for the program or you not being able to meet the necessary ongoing student visa conditions under the laws of Australia or overseas; and
- 4. send to the relevant Faculty any additional fees associated with you undertaking the program, including for example, books, meals, local transportation, and incidental expenses incurred throughout the program.
- 5. abide by all laws of the foreign country where the program runs

You acknowledge and agree that you will be responsible for all living, travel, insurance and ancillary costs in connection with the program, unless otherwise agreed and approved in writing by an authorised representative of the University of Sydney or United States Studies Centre.

Academic Credit

You will be responsible for agreeing any specific academic credit arrangements for the program with the Faculty of Arts and Social Science, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Engineering and IT and The Business School in accordance with the University of Sydney's or University of New South Wales rules, policies and procedures for such arrangements prior to the commencement of the program.

Upon completion of the program at UCLA, it will be your own responsibility to obtain a UCLA transcript at your cost to provide to your University of Sydney or University of New South Wales faculty advisor for processing your credit.



Code of Conduct for Students

During your visit to UCLA, you will continue to be an enrolled student of the University of Sydney or the University of New South Wales, and as such you must remember to act safely and responsibly at all times. For your information, I have **enclosed** a copy of the *Code of Conduct for Students*, which sets out the expected standards of personal behaviour which are required to be demonstrated.

If you do not understand the requirements as set out in the *Code of Conduct for Students*, please contact Amelia Trial, Student Mobility Manager at the United States Studies Centre to discuss.

You should be aware that if the University of Sydney or United States Studies Centre is advised of conduct by you which may amount, if proven, to a breach of the *Code of Conduct for Students*, disciplinary action may be taken against you.

If UCLA is not satisfied that you can conduct yourself in a safe or professional manner, or you are in breach of any requirements notified to you by UCLA, then they may suspend or terminate your participation in the program. The University of Sydney takes no responsibility whatsoever for suspension or termination by UCLA in these circumstances.
